The TG Health Information Network (TG HIN) enables patients, providers and payors to share information and leverage the full strength of the data to bring better outcomes and wellness.

Timmaron Group focuses on the total population of a community, bringing all clinical and ancillary health services, including hospitals, clinics, pharmacy, transitional care facilities, ear, eye, chiropractic, behavioral and public health services, to improve health for your total population.

Critical elements in an HIN:

- 1. The Electronic Health Record (EHR). The HIN brings all the data in a community together and helps bridge the gaps in varied technologies, regardless of their protocols. If information is inside an electronic health record (EHR), the HIN network will:
 - Aggregate, normalize and deduplicate data from multiple systems, records, and CCDs to create a single, comprehensive, longitudinal patient CCD.
 - Utilize protocol bridging technology to break down varying technology barriers.
 - Support bi-directional queries between networks with a "one to many" connectivity approach, effectively creating a "network of networks" that eliminates barriers to information sharing.
- 2. **The Community Health Record (CHR).** TG HIN Community Health Record (CHR) portal combines available data from across multiple settings: hospitals, pharmacies, labs, primary care physicians, specialists, long-term and post-acute care facilities, patient-centered medical homes, and even public health organizations:
 - Provides fast, simple access to longitudinal patient information from across the community for better quality and emergency care.
 - Improves care coordination and delivers key information for care transitions.
 - Eliminates the complexity of continuity of care document (CCD) exchange.
 - Empowers clinicians and authorized users with a comprehensive view of a patient's clinical history.
 - Enables a simple way for providers to securely collaborate on patient care and share clinical information.

With these main elements, a community and the HIE can bring significant value to improving health and the actions that are needed to do so.
